Change is Coming

Here's a peek at the new location and the current needs.

In last month's newsletter HFM presented 3 possible options for the ministry in regards to our current lease's end and moving forward. With much prayer and fasting, option 3 was chosen. Here is a quick reminder of the choice made:

Option 3: Move to a new location. HFM viewed a newer property the afternoon of Thursday, February 14. This location is in a very high trafficked area and sits in a very visible area. The ministry would have 1200 square feet of usable space for the ministry, including: 1 vocal studio, 1 instrumental studio, reception and lobby area, main office, a room for group sessions, restroom, and a large garage for storage or additional studio space. This option, while giving the ministry the much sought after space also almost doubles our lease amount. With this option the ministry would also take on some utility costs that it currently is not paying.

While the decision has been made to move forward with option 3 there are several things that need to come together rather quickly in order to see this decision come to fruition. That is where we need your help.

1. Move in costs. There are upfront costs that we must have in order to sign the lease and take possession of the property. Including security deposits (lease, gas/electric, water/sewer and trash), installation fees (phone/internet), and a little bit of cosmetic work we are looking at a financial need of \$3,000 - \$3,500.

2. Office furniture. We will be in need of desks, desk chairs, credenzas, filing cabinets, bookshelves, chairs for the lobby area, etc. If you know of someone who has any of this type of office furniture please let us know.

3. We will need help setting up the new space. If you would like to help us with any of the manual labor portion of the setup we welcome your help.

4. Grand Opening. We have tentatively set a date for our grand opening (see article on page 2). As a part of the grand opening we are looking to have fun things for families to do. We will be looking for volunteers to come and participate. (face painting, balloon animals, cotton candy, snow cones, hair cuts, live music, etc.) If you have suggestions or if there is something you would like to offer, please reach out to us soon.

5. Not only do we have move in costs but there is an opportunity for you to become a ministry partner by financially donating to our ongoing ministry.

Again, we ask that you would continue to cover us with your thoughts and prayers as we move forward in faith and in ministry.

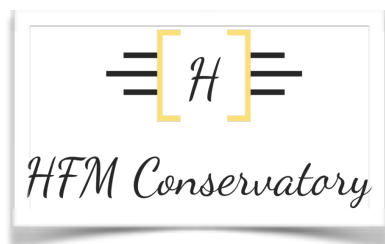

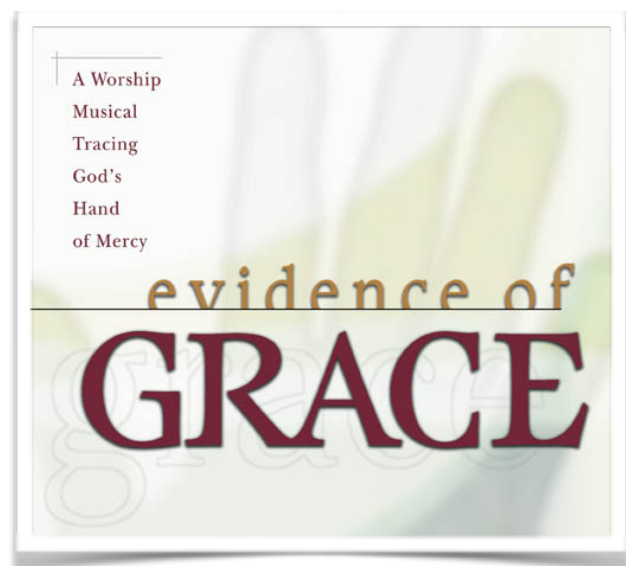
Updates from
