Here's a peek at the new location  
and the current needs.

It is really happening. We signed the lease on Thursday, March 14 and will be able to start working on the space on the 15 of March. The majority of work that needs to be done to the space is in the room that will be the instrumental studio. Currently there is no ceiling in this room and due to the sound that will be generated during lessons we must install a drop

ceiling and some lighting. There is also a need to add some sound absorbing wall tiles in both the instrumental and vocal studios. Our goal is to be operating out of our new space on April 1 or before. God has really proven Himself as the ultimate provider throughout this process. We are excited to see how He will continue to fulfill the new and current needs we still have. 1. **Remaining Move In Costs.** We have taken possession of the 109 Walker Drive location and still have a little ways to go in order to be able ready to hold lessons and ministry services by April 1. There are still a few other items to take care of before we officially open on April 1. plus the costs of painting, cleaning, and a little bit of cosmetic work on a couple of walls and installing a door. Due to the addition of an actual phone networking service plus the additional licensing issues with the IRS and the county we have increased our original \$3,500 goal to \$4,250. Currently we have received almost \$3,000 leaving us with a remaining \$1,250 left to raise. If you would like to donate to the cause there are three different ways to do so. With the automotive repairs we are looking to be able to identify the problems and fix easy repairs, such as headlight/blinker replacement, fuse replacement, etc...

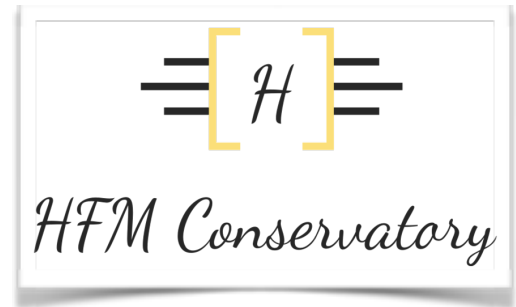
## Grand Opening Scheduled

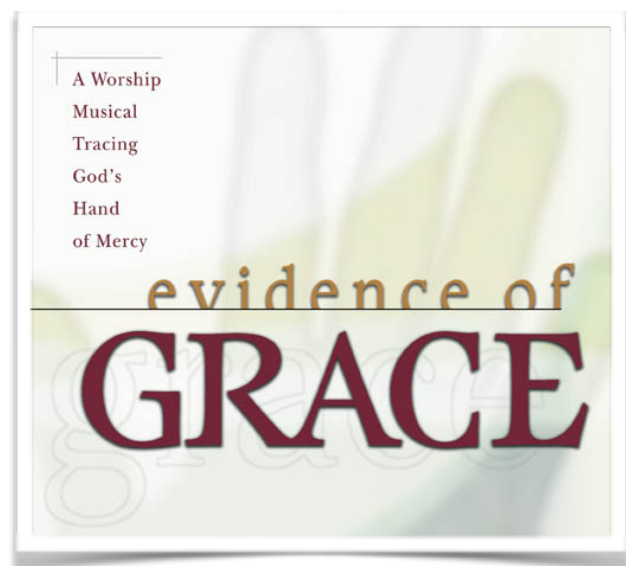
## Updates from

HFM Conservatory is growing, too! In the HFM Headquarters, the Conservatory will be able to start offering instrumental lessons. We will begin with beginning percussion and branch out from there.
